

We are calling for entries to **A4 Art Australia**, an initiative and exhibition opportunity from **The Contemporary Art Society of Victoria**.


I would be most grateful if you would pass on this information to your membership or other associated groups/artists by posting online or including in your bulletin, newsletter, website, etc.

Contemporary artists are invited to submit up to **four** (4) **A4-sized artworks** for the exhibition.



Awards

Three cash awards are given for the work that best demonstrates an overall artistic impression and uniqueness of concept. Consideration will be given to innovative ways of delivering the message, the clarity and quality of submission as well as colour, lighting, exposure and focus.

1st Prize is \$300; 2nd Prize is \$200 and 3rd Prize is \$100.

Exhibition

Selected works will be exhibited at ArtSpace from 31 March to 4 May, 2020 with an opening on 5 April from 2 - 4pm. All entries will be eligible for judging and the judge's decision will be final.

Fees

A non-refundable fee of \$15 per entry will apply with all fees donated to the Gippsland Emergency Relief Fund (GERF). Entries close 24th of March. Your work must be delivered to ArtSpace no later than 4pm on Sunday 29th of March. Artwork must be picked up on Monday 4th of May.
